- -Delivering over 75,000 hot and frozen Meals on Wheels throughout Grey-Bruce
- -Providing over 15,000 hours of housekeeping services
- -Providing over 50,000 accessible and volunteer transportation trips across Grey Bruce and South-West Ontario
- -Providing over 500 nights of overnight respite support
- -Providing over 150,000 hours of day-program support over 6 locations
- -Providing over 1800 friendly visiting calls and visits to over 100 clients
