The Family & Client Care Coordinator is responsible for providing education, information, counselling and support to caregivers of clients. Administer nursing care during overnight and daytime hours, assistance with activities for the clients attending the Markdale and Saugeen Central Adult Day Program. Responsible for the intake and assessment of new clients for our community-based support services, introducing new clients and their family members to the programs of HCSS Grey-Bruce

Must have a Current registration with the College of Nurses and awareness of community service delivery. A valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle is required. Applicants must have a minimum of three to five years' experience working with the elderly and the physically challenged and their families. Knowledge of Alzheimer Disease and related disorders, and previous experience working with volunteers is required.

Will need to be available to work evenings and nights in our Overnight Respite Program as well as hours in our Adult Day Program during the week.
