ELIGIBILITY	Patients, families, or health care professionals can contact OHAH to request an eligibility assessment by a Care Coordinator. Care Coordinators support patient assessment in hospitals, in the community, and on the phone.	Anyone requiring the services above can contact Central Intake to review their needs.
COSTS	No cost for eligible services with a valid OHIP card.	Programs are heavily subsidized by Ministry of Health, community fundraising, donations, and thousands of volunteer hours, however, small user fees may apply.
